## **Dear North Bradford on Avon and Villages Churches family**

First of all, a very Happy New Year to you all! I hope your Christmas was blessed, if perhaps simpler and quieter than usual.

In view of the latest national lockdown and rapidly rising COVID infections, along with our church leaders, I have taken the difficult decision to suspend public worship in our churches for the next few weeks or so....for the following reasons:

- 1) Although confident we have been operating safely so far, until more information is available, we cannot be absolutely sure the measures we have in place are adequate to prevent the new, more transmissible, strain of COVID virus.
- 2) Considering the average age of those who've been attending (and, crucially, staffing) our services, it would be unwise to ask many of you to come out at present.
- 3) Given that the public health message is again to *stay at home and protect the NHS*, I believe we should show solidarity with this national effort and, for a short time, forgo the privilege of meeting together... even though it is still allowed in law.

We will keep this under constant review and recommence public worship as soon as it seems the right thing to do.

In these circumstances, it is important to continue taking advantage of every means of sustaining our worship and fellowship in other ways. So, to remind you of some of those:

1) YouTube Services are posted every week on our website but the link can also be emailed to you direct each Saturday ready to watch together in our homes on Sunday morning. There is also a wealth of other worship available online, for example, from Salisbury Cathedral, from other churches in our Deanery and from the BBC.

St Peter's Monkton Farleigh, Sundays and Wednesdays 10.00 am – 12.00 noon
