church is at work today. Each child will have the chance through crafts, activities and reflections, to see how the church welcomes, teaches, prays, celebrates and serves as they explore the font, pulpit, kneelers, altar and stained glass. The final session will concentrate on the church door and how the church shares.

RECTOR VACANCY UPDATE

Last Sunday, 3rd September, the four PCCs met and agreed that the Benefice Profile is now ready and consequently it has been signed off and sent to the diocese. Thank you to everybody who provided comments on the draft last month – your input was very helpful. The final version is being placed on the Benefice website, and there will be a small number of printed copies available in each church and at Avon Park.

The PCCs have also agreed that the four Parish Representatives to be involved with the interviews are:

Christchurch: Margaret Thompson Monkton Farleigh: Colin Exley South Wraxall: Valentine Thornhill

Winsley: Linds Batson

The other members of the interview panel will be the Bishop of Ramsbury the Rt Rev Andrew Rumsey, the Archdeacon of Wiltshire the Ven Sue Groom and our local rural dean Rev Jane Palmer.

Now, we move onto the next stage of the process. As we have explained previously, there is a preferred candidate who has expressed an interest in coming to our Benefice but they will still need to apply and go through the interview process in the normal way. The diocese will send them the Profile and if they are still interested they will apply in the next month or so. The interview panel will meet around the middle of October to decide whether to interview the applicant, and if they proceed to interview stage there will be an orientation day on 31st October (when the candidate will visit all four parishes, a school and the rectory) followed by a formal interview on 1st November. There will be more information about this nearer the time. If the candidate is appointed, they will probably need to serve out 3 months' notice in their current role. If for any reason the candidate is not appointed the incumbency will be advertised in the Church Times during November with dates already set for shortlisting and interviews in January and February 2024.

The work of the Profile Writing Group is almost complete. We have a meeting in early October to plan the orientation day, and if necessary we will meet subsequently to write the advertisement for the Church Times. Meanwhile, we trust and pray that God will lead us to the right person for this Benefice.





Project Update

September 2023 - Conservation and Repairs are Underway

- The scaffolding has been erected around the spire as restoration work is carried out following repairs to the internal flooring and electrics.
- The clock restoration has begun. The clock has been removed and is currently with Smith of Derby who will be carrying out the repairs. The clock faces will be regilded and the mechanism will soon be working again.
- The steeplejack will be on site soon to repair the damage to the spire and restore the large south west carved stone pinnacle.
