Bishop Stephen has asked us to return to administering wine, using the Common Cup, without intinction, from Pentecost.

Christ Church, St James and St Peter's are now following this. Bishop Stephen reminds us that receiving bread only constitutes full Communion so there is no need to intinct or receive from the Cup if you would prefer not to.
