Oil Spill threatens wildlife and beaches.

Many of you will have read in the news recently about the oil that has washed up on the beaches of Israel / Palestine. Sadly the oil has also affected some of the beaches in southern Lebanon, including the Nature Reserve at Tyre, an important site for turtle breeding. Only last September we were reading that as Lebanon reeled from multiple tragedies, conservationists were pointing to one bright spot: a record number of endangered green sea turtles coming to nest on the country's shores. Loggerhead turtles have also come in large numbers. The oil spill now threatens the breeding grounds of these turtles. As is often the case in Lebanon, much of the clean up is being organised by local NGO's, though further to the north in Sidon, the public were told it was too risky to go to the beach and that trained teams would be conducting a survey and assessing the damage. In any case, travelling in Lebanon has been difficult for the past couple of weeks due to roads being closed by people protesting about the failing economy.


