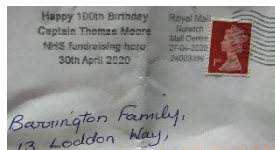

Chinese it was super, it was clear plates all round. Then we found one of my favourite

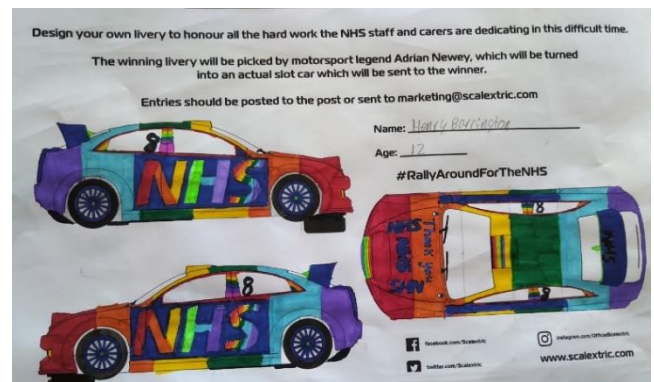
